MCP TO PROVIDE GSM SERVICES ON BOARD POLFERRIES' MF SCANDINAVIA

Grimstad/Warzawa, September 5th, 2006: Maritime Communications Partner AS (MCP) has signed a contract with Fincom - Materna Communications (FMC) to deliver GSM and SMS services on board Polferries' ship MF Scandinavia. MF Scandinavia sails several times weekly from the picturesque port Nynäshamn, a short drive from Stockholm, to the cultural and economic centre Gdańsk in Poland. So far Polferries, the operating name of the Polish Baltic Shipping company, is the only Polish operator sailing between Sweden and Poland providing this service.

The service enables passengers and crew on board cruise-ships, ferries and other vessels around the world, to make and receive calls and SMS using their own mobile phones and phone numbers.

For the passengers, the mobile services are transparent, readily available on their own personal mobile phone, operating seamlessly through MCP's network in the same way as when travelling abroad. MCP tariffs all calls, and handles the revenue flow generated by the networks, through industry standard billing and accounting systems. The customers are charged by their home operator by normal invoicing routines.
